

COMMISSIONER MEETING OF JUNE 8, 2012

The Caribou County Commissioners met in regular session on June 8, 2012, at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Lloyd Rasmussen, Commissioner Chairman, Earl Somsen Commissioner and Phil Christensen. Also in attendance were Caribou County Clerk Veda Mascarenas, Road and Bridge Supervisor Kim Spencer, Caribou County Sheriff Ric Anderson, Building Department Ralph Hopkins, Weed Supervisor Scott Shuler, Courthouse Maintenance and Grounds Jordan Bodily; Building Inspector Ralph Hopkins;

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance and prayer.

Kim Spencer, Road and Bridge:

- The letter from Christina Stoker was discussed. The board of commissioners decided that no further action was required.
- The budget review reflected no increase in operations but will request the following:
 - Road and Bridge – purchase of one tractor, 3 pickups or upgrade crusher for \$272,000.00
 - Mineral Leasing – 12-14 loads of oil \$100,000.00 and upgrade grader or truck for \$135,000.00
 - Solid Waste – Upgrade D6 cat or buy property to use for dirt cover for \$175,000.00

Ralph Hopkins, Building Inspector:

- Budget review reflected a decrease of \$500.00

Scott Shuler, Weed Supervisor:

- The budget review reflected an increase of \$1000.00 for purchase of chemicals.
- Spraying is behind about 7-8 days. However, there is time to catch up.
- The Bag of Woad program started on June 11, 2012.

Jordan Bodily, Courthouse and Grounds

- Budget review reflected a decrease of \$37,150.00.

Rick Anderson, Caribou County Sheriff:

- Budget review reflected and increase of \$112,449.00 for vehicle expense, Motorola tower fee increase, juvenile housing, armor vests for law enforcement, moving of dispatch center to

conference room, cleaning supplies, booking supplies and laundry supplies due to increased inmates and replacement of equipment for the jail.

- An increase of \$500.00 for the training in the GIS department.

Other:

- Commissioner Christensen moved to pay the claims in the amount of \$48,012.70 and payroll claims in the amount of \$142,639.75, and to approve the minutes of May 29, 2012, commissioner meetings as presented. Commissioner Somsen seconded the motion. The vote was Rasmussen-yes, Christensen-yes and Somsen-yes.
- The board of commissioners traveled to area of the proposed RS2477 located by the Agrium mine. Other to be in attendance were John Tippets, Tony Varilone, and Craig Shuler.
- The meeting adjourned at 12:00 noon. The Caribou County Board of Commissioners will meet June 25, 2012, at 9:00 a.m. for regular meeting.
