

COMMISSIONER MEETING OF APRIL 3, 2014

The Caribou County Commissioners met in special session on April 3, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. Those in attendance were Phil Christensen and Mark Mathews Commissioners. Also in attendance were Caribou County Clerk Veda Mascarenas, Road and Bridge Supervisor Kim Spencer.

Commissioner Mathews moved to convene to executive session pursuant to I.C. 67-2345(b) "To consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent, or public school student." at 1:00 p.m. Commissioner Christensen seconded the motion. The vote was Somsen – yes, Christensen – yes, and Mathews – yes. Commissioner Christensen moved to reconvene to regular session at 1:15 p.m. Commissioner Mathews second the motion. The vote was Somsen – yes, Christensen – yes, and Mathews – yes.

Decision:

Commissioner Mathews moved to terminate the employee because he had violated the terms and conditions of the Caribou County Policy and Procedures Manual, pursuant to Section 3(C) 15. "Employees of Caribou County shall not engage in criminal conduct of any kind while on duty or off. Caribou County employees are expected to behave in a lawful and socially acceptable manner and failure to do so is a violation of the trust placed in such employees by the public and the appointing official." Commissioner Christensen seconded the motion. The vote was Somsen – yes, Christensen – yes, and Mathews – yes.
