

COMMISSIONER MEETING OF JULY 11, 2011

The Caribou County Commissioners met in regular session on June 11, 2011, at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Lloyd Rasmussen, Commissioner Chairman, Earl Somsen Commissioner and Phil Christensen. Also in attendance were Caribou County Clerk Veda Mascarenas, Road and Bridge Supervisor Kim Spencer, Prosecuting Attorney Gregg Haney, Jordan Bodily, Courthouse and Grounds Maintenance, Indigent Director Denise Horsley, Tony Varilone, Clark Bitton, Neil Larson, and Aaron Cook.

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance and prayer.

Commissioner Somsen moved to add Tony Varilone to agenda. Commissioner Christensen seconded the motion. The vote was Christensen-yes; Somsen-yes, Rasmussen-yes.

Commissioner Rasmussen stated the 2:00 p.m. meeting with John Tippetts – Aguim – RS2477 Private Road has been canceled.

Kim Spencer, Road and Bridge

- 2.5 miles of Blackfoot River Road has been torn up and will be completed July 22.
- The 15,000 gallon fuel tank is here.
- The magnesium chloride bladder has a leak. The crew is working to fix the leak.
- Kim is working with Bingham County and will be ready to shoot oil the last 2 weeks of August.
- A 3' culvert has been placed on Ivans Road
- Working on culverts in Diamond Creek and Rasmussen Valley
- Commissioner Christensen requested Cow Camp Road be bladed. Commissioner Somsen requested Bridge Creek Road be worked on
- 6 loads of gravel was put on Stump Creek and 6 loads on Tin Cup Junction.

Denise Horsley, Indigent Director:

- Commissioner Christensen moved to accept 70% of the balance owed (\$69,743.12) of indigent case No. 08-14 and 09-19 for a total of \$48,820.18. Commissioner Somsen seconded the motion. The vote was Christensen-yes; Somsen-yes, Rasmussen-yes.

Board of Equalization:

Commissioner Christensen moved to convene as Board of Equalization. Commissioner Somsen seconded the motion. The vote was Christensen-yes; Somsen-yes, Rasmussen-yes.

The matter came on for hearing on parcel number RL4154A. Those present were Clark Bitton, Neil Larson, Aaron Cook and Gregg Haney. Clark Bitton requested the value on the parcel be decreased rather than increased.

The board of commissioners will enter a written decision within 30 days.

Tony Varilone, Soda Springs Pathway Project:

- Discussed a pathway to continue from the existing pathway on the Government Dam Road to Kelly Park.


Other:
