

COMMISSIONER MEETING OF September 28, 2015

The Caribou County Commissioners met in regular session on September 28, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance for the first hour were Earl Somsen, Commission Chairman, Phil Christensen, and Mark Mathews, Commissioners. Also in attendance were Caribou County Clerk Denise Horsley, Indigent Director Wendy Rasmussen.

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance and prayer.

Wendy Rasmussen, Indigent Director:

- Commissioner Mathews made the motion to approve indigent 2015-14 because the applicant is medically indigent. Commissioner Christensen seconded the motion. The vote was Somsen-yes, Christensen-yes, and Mathews-yes.
- Commissioners signed Liens for Indigent Case Number 2015-15 & 2015-16.

Other:


- Commissioner Christensen moved to pay the claims in the amount \$141,901.74 of and payroll claims in the amount of \$150,902.34 and to approve the minutes of September 14, 2015, as amended, and amend the claims for September 14, 2015 to \$273,314.99 because a claim was not included in the total. Commissioner Mathews seconded the motion. The vote was Somsen-yes, Christensen-yes and Mathews-yes.
- The Commissioners were presented with Lease Agreement with Valley Office System for the Extension Office Copier. The agreement was signed by the Commissioners.
- The Commissioners were presented with The Terrorism Coverage Rejection form and the Joint Powers Agreement from ICRMP to sign. The agreements were signed by the Commissioners.
- Commissioner Mathews made the motion to add Balls Road to the agenda. Commissioner Christensen seconded the motion. The vote was Somsen-yes, Christensen-yes, and Mathews-yes. Commissioner Mathews received a text message from Chet Hopkins with his concerns about the Road and Bridge Department grading and maintaining Balls Road, but not maintaining Aftons Way per the agreement that the homeowners in the Aftons Subdivision have with the County. Chet was under the understanding that the County was to maintain the Aftons Way. The Commissioners agreed that the County was to maintain the Road. Commissioner Mathews will get in touch with Kim and discuss this issue. The Commissioners also want Commissioner Mathews to discuss with Kim about making the Last Chance Road a County Road.
