

COMMISSIONER MEETING OF OCTOBER 7, 2011

The Caribou County Commissioners met in regular session on October 7, 2011, at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Lloyd Rasmussen, Commissioner Chairman, Earl Somsen Commissioner and Phil Christensen. Also in attendance were Caribou County Clerk Veda Mascarenas, Road and Bridge Supervisor Kim Spencer, Prosecuting Attorney Gregg Haney, Indigent Director Denise Horsley, Caribou County Sheriff Rick Anderson, Building Inspector, Ralph Hopkins.

Kim Spencer, Road and Bridge:

- The board of commissioners and Kim traveled to the Bart Rhead proposed road site to review the grade and safety of the road. No decision was made.
- The radios and repeater will cost \$18,937 which is under the 2012 budget of \$20,000. The radios and repeater are in conjunction to the 700 MHz. The board of commissioners approved the expenditure.
- The purchase order forms and procedure was approved by the board of commissioners. Implementation of the purchase order system will start immediately.
- The board of commissioners will meet with the Road and Bridge employees October 19, 2011, at the Alexander site, at 6:00 a.m. to answer questions and try to resolve any issues.

Rick Anderson:

- Discussed the savings of the food service contract. The comparison was for the years of 2008 – 2011. The conclusion was having the contract with the food service has proven to be a good investment and has saved the county money.

Ralph Hopkins:

- Requested vacation from October 17, to 21st, 2011. Blake Poulsen will cover the inspections he has scheduled.
- Ralph reported on the water resource conference he attended. The conference was informative and there is a web site that people can find information on specific to the property in question.
- A few building permits have been issued.

Denise Horsley, Indigent Director:

- Denise presented application #11-33 lien and #11-21 release of lien for signature.



- The sealed bids were opened for the old vault that was in the Magistrate Court Clerk's office. Susan Speelmon bid \$308.00 and Phil Christensen bid \$52.01.
- The meeting adjourned at 12:00 p.m. The Caribou County Board of Commissioners will meet October 24, 2011, at 9:00 a.m. for regular meeting.
