

ORDINANCE NO. 00-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4, ORDINANCES OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, PASSED MAY 12, 1975, REGULATING CAMPING WITHIN THE CARIBOU COUNTY PARK, TO EXTEND SAID ORDINANCE TO OREGON TRAIL PARK, BLACKFOOT PARK, HOPKINS' LANDING, PEBBLE BEACH AND UTAH BEACH, LONE TREE, GOVERNMENT DAM, CHESTERFIELD RESERVOIR, AND TWENTY-FOUR MILE; FURTHER AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE TO REFLECT THAT NO VEHICLE OR TRAILER SHALL PARK ON ANY MAINTAINED/GROOMED GRASS AREA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; WAIVING THE RULE THAT ORDINANCE BE READ ON THREE SEPARATE OCCASIONS.

BE IS ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** Section II of Ordinance No. 4, passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, on May 12, 1975, is hereby deleted, and the following language is substituted therefore:

**Section 2.** Overnight camping shall be allowed within Caribou County Park located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 16, Township 7 South, Range 42 East, B.M.; the Oregon Trail Park located in Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 41 East, B.M.; Hopkins' Landing located in Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 41 East, B.M.; Pebble Beach and Utah Beach located in Section 26, Township 5 South, Range 41 East, B.M.; Lone Tree located in Section 4, Township 6 South, Range 42 East, B.M.; Government Dam located in Section 12, Township 5 South, Range 41 East, B.M.; Chesterfield Reservoir located in Section 24, Township 6 South, Range 38 East, B.M.; and Twenty-Four Mile located in Section 16, Township 6 South, Range 39 East, B.M.

**Section 2:** Section 4 is hereby amended to add the following language thereto:

**Section 4.** Camping in the park area shall be for recreational purposes only, and the overnight occupancy of any space within the park is expressly forbidden except as provided above

No vehicle or trailer shall be parked on any maintained or groomed grass area of any park.


**Section 3:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 4:** All portions of Ordinance No. 4 dated May 12, 1975, and all portions of Ordinance No. 88-3 which did amend a portion of Ordinance No. 4, not specifically repealed or amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 5:** The rule requiring that this ordinance be read on three separate occasions is hereby waived.


**Section 6:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
