BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, pursuant to a meeting held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1975 by the Board of County Commissioners for the purpose of eradicating confusion and for the public interest that that road presently known as Eight Mile Road, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point located on U.S. Highway 30 North in Section 7, Township 9 South, Range 42 East, B.M.; and thence proceeding in a Southerly direction to the Caribou County and Bear Lake County boundaries,

shall be henceforth named and designated the "BAILEY CREEK ROAD".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, pursuant to a meeting held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1975 that that road presently known as the Eight Mile Road and intersecting with the now designated "BAILEY CREEK ROAD", located in Section 32, Township 9 South, Range 42 East, B.M.; and thence running in a Southeasterly direction to the Caribou County and Bear Lake County boundaries, shall henceforth be designated as the "EIGHT MILE ROAD".
