

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CAMPING WITHIN
THE CARIBOU COUNTY PARK, LOCATED ON THE
BLACKFOOT RIVER, CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of
Caribou County, Idaho.

Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate
the use of the park area described herein for recreational
camping and to prevent permanent occupancy of space therein
and to insure that all persons shall have the opportunity
to use the camping facilities of said park.

*Hopkins Landing
12th Street
Caribou, Idaho*

Section 2. Overnight camping shall be allowed within
that Caribou County Park, located in Caribou County, Idaho,
said park being located in the N 1/2 of the N 1/2 of Section
16, Township 7 South, Range 42 East, B.M.

Section 3. Overnight camping in the above-mentioned park
area shall be limited to each person for a period of no longer
than nine (9) days. At the end of said nine (9) day period,
the person or persons having camped in the park area shall
remove person, belongings and vehicles from the park area.
Re-entrance to the park area by said person or persons, for
the purpose of overnight camping, after they have left the
same, shall not be permitted for a period of seven (7) days
after the departure from the park area.

Section 4. Camping in the park area shall be for recrea-
tional purposes only, and the overnight occupancy of any
space within the park is expressly forbidden except as
provided above.

Section 5. PENALTY: Any person violating the provisions
of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor,
punishable by a fine not to exceed THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)
or by jail sentence not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both
said fine and imprisonment.
