

O R D I N A N C E NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE PASSED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, PROHIBITING ALL PERSONS WITHIN CARIBOU COUNTY FROM OPERATING SPRINKLER IRRIGATION SYSTEMS ON THEIR PROPERTY OR PROPERTIES IN THEIR RIGHTFUL POSSESSION IN SUCH A MANNER WHEREBY WATER FROM THE SPRINKLER IRRIGATION SYSTEMS FALL UPON COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAYS.

Be it ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, that all persons are hereby prohibited from operating sprinkler irrigation systems on any property located in the confines of Caribou County, Idaho, in such a manner that water from said sprinkler irrigation systems falls upon or in any way sprays or sprinkles the Caribou County road right of way, and all persons shall locate said sprinkler irrigation systems on their property in such a manner that the water from said systems does not fall upon, spray, or sprinkle said County road right of ways.

In order to comply with the provisions of the above stated paragraph of this ordinance, persons shall locate sprinkler irrigation lines on any property within Caribou County at least 45 feet from any County road right of way when said lines run parallel to said road right of way. All sprinkler irrigation system lines running perpendicular to a County road right of way shall have a splash guard or screen on the riser of said sprinkler line closest to the road to prevent water from falling upon, spraying, or sprinkling said County road right of way.

Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and that each day said violation continues shall constitute a separate offense, and each violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100.00.
