

ORDINANCE NO. 80-1

AN ORDINANCE PROSCRIBING THE FIRING OF RIFLES, SHOT GUNS, PISTOLS, REVOLVERS OR OTHER WEAPONS OR FIREARMS WITHIN A ONE-HALF MILE RADIUS OF THE CEDAR VIEW SUBDIVISION AND ADDITION NO. 1 TO THE CEDAR VIEW SUBDIVISION, SAID SUBDIVISION BEING LOCATED IN CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge rifles, shot guns, pistols, revolvers or other firearms of any kind or description within a one-half mile radius of the Cedar View Subdivision and Addition No. 1 to the Cedar View Subdivision, said subdivisions being located within the County of Caribou, State of Idaho, and the descriptions of which are on file and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Caribou County, Idaho in the Book of Plats, under instruments No. 45765 and 54744 respectively.

Section 2: The term "firearm" as used in this ordinance shall mean any instrument capable of propulsion of hot, shell, or bullet, or other harmful objects by the action of gun powder exploded within it, or by the action of compressed air within it, or by the power of springs and including what are commonly known as air-rifles and B-B guns.

Section 3: Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by confinement in the County Jail for a period of not to exceed six (6) months and/or a fine of \$300.00.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

Section 5: This ordinance shall repeal any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.
