

ORDINANCE NO. 81-4

AN ORDINANCE OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 78-4 TO DELETE SECTION 3 THEREOF AND SUBSTITUTING A NEW SECTION 3 PRESCRIBING SPEED LIMITS ON COUNTY ROADS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, IDAHO, AND PRESCRIBING SPEED LIMITS FOR PLATTED SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO; REPEALING THAT RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO ON NOVEMBER 27, 1978, WHICH SAID RESOLUTION PRESCRIBED CERTAIN SPEED LIMITS FOR DIFFERENT ROADS WITHIN THE COUNTY; REPEALING SECTION 2, ORDINANCE NO. 78-3, ORDINANCES OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO; PROHIBITING THE POSTING OR ERECTION OF ANY TRAFFIC REGULATION SIGNS BY PERSONS OR ENTITIES OTHER THAN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND ANY RESOLUTION PRESCRIBING CERTAIN SPEED LIMITS AND PROVIDING A DATE BY WHICH THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, STATE OF IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 78-4, Ordinances of Caribou County, Idaho, is hereby amended to delete Section 3 of said Ordinance and substitute therefor the following section:

"Section 3:

A. The maximum speed limit for motor vehicles driven on the following county roads shall be 55 miles per hour:

1. That asphalt paved road which intersects with Highway U.S. 30 and Highway 34 running West to the Bannock County line through the City of Bancroft, Idaho, the same being known as the old U.S. Highway 30.
2. That county road or highway running in a southerly direction from the City of Bancroft, Idaho, to Lund, Idaho.
3. That county road or highway running west of the city limits of Grace, Idaho, to the junction of the North-South County Road, said junction being approximately 4½ miles west of Grace, Idaho, known as the Turner Road.

B. The maximum speed limit for motor vehicles driven on all other county roads within Caribou County, Idaho, which said roads are asphalt surface roads shall be 45 miles per hour.

C. The maximum speed limit for motor vehicles driven on all county roads or highways in Caribou County, Idaho, which said roads are graded and maintained by the County of Caribou, Idaho, covered with gravel, cinders, dirt, or other similar surfacing, will be 35 miles per hour."

Section 2: That resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, dated November

27, 1978, pertaining to the speed limit of motor vehicles on County Roads within the County of Caribou, Idaho, is hereby repealed.

Section 3: Section 2, Ordinance No. 78-3, Ordinances of Caribou County, Idaho, is hereby repealed.

Section 4: Traffic regulatory signs controlling the speed of traffic or other operations of motor vehicles within the county shall be the sole responsibility of the county, and no person shall erect or post any sign or other devices limiting or controlling the speed of any motor vehicle, nor shall said person or persons erect any other signs or devices pertaining to the traffic regulation of motor vehicles.

Section 5: Any person or persons committing an act in violation of this ordinance or who drive motor vehicles at a speed in excess of the maximum speed limits as set by this ordinance, or by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, of Caribou County, Idaho, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$300.00 or imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed six months or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
