

ORDINANCE NO. 85-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, STATE OF IDAHO, PROHIBITING SMOKING WITHIN THE CARIBOU COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND DESIGNATING CERTAIN AREAS WHERE SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1: Smoking is hereby prohibited in all portions of the Caribou County Courthouse located at 159 South Main Street, Soda Springs, Idaho, in all areas to which the public has access with the exception of the following:

- a. Room 301 - jury room
- b. Restrooms
- c. All judicial chambers or other offices which are not normally accessible to the general public except upon invitation of the person or persons occupying the same in performance of their designated duties, so long as permitted by said person or persons.

Section 2: The term "smoking" is defined as the carrying or possession of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any other matter or substance which contains tobacco.

Section 3: Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction and be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.00.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
