

ORDINANCE NO. 88-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4, ORDINANCES OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, PASSED MAY 12, 1975, REGULATING CAMPING WITHIN THE CARIBOU COUNTY PARK TO EXTEND OVERNIGHT CAMPING TO A PERIOD OF TEN DAYS AND PROHIBITING PETS RUNNING AT LARGE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 4, Ordinances of Caribou County, Idaho, passed May 12, 1975, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Overnight camping in the above-mentioned park area shall be limited to each person and/or vehicle for a period of no longer than ~~nine-(9)~~ ten (10) days. At the end of said ~~nine-(9)~~ ten (10) day period, the person or persons having camped in the park area shall remove person, belongings, and vehicles from the park area. Re-entrance to the park area by said person or persons, for the purpose of overnight camping, after they have left the same, shall not be permitted for a period of seven (7) days after the departure from the park area. All dogs or other pets shall be prohibited from running at large within the Caribou County Park, and the owner or other person possessing said dog or pet shall cause said animal to be placed upon a leash at all times.

h Section No. 2. All other provisions contained in the above mentioned Ordinance not specifically amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and affect.

Section No. 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
