

ORDINANCE NO. 90-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU,
STATE OF IDAHO, PERMITTING THE SALE OF
LIQUOR BY THE DRINK ON SUNDAYS, MEMORIAL
DAY, AND THANKSGIVING, WITHIN THE
COUNTY, SUBJECT TO CITY APPROVAL WITHIN
INCORPORATED AREAS OF THE COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The sale of liquor by the drink on Sundays,
Memorial Day and Thanksgiving, is hereby approved for all
establishments located within Caribou County having the
required state, county and city liquor licenses. However,
prior to the sale of liquor by the drink by any
establishment located within any incorporated area within
the county, it shall be mandatory that the governing body of
said incorporated area first pass and approve an ordinance
authorizing the sale of liquor by the drink within said
incorporated area.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, approval and publication
according to law.
