**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, STATE OF IDAHO, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR ALL MOTOR VEHICLE TRAVEL ON THE LAST CHANCE ROAD AND FOR MOTOR VEHICLE TRUCK TRAVEL ON THE TRAIL CREEK ROAD; ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR SAID VEHICLES ON SAID ROAD AS 25 MILES PER HOUR; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: No person shall drive a motor vehicle truck, excepting pick-up trucks of a size of 1 ton or less, at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour on that portion of the Trail Canyon Road, located in Caribou County, Idaho, in Township 8 South, Range 42 East, Boise Meridian, beginning at the section corner common to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34; thence East 1320 feet to the Southeast Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27; thence Northeast along the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and continuing Northeast along the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  to the East line of Section 27; thence Northeast across the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26 of the above mentioned township and range.

Section 2: No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour on the Last Chance Road, located in Caribou County, Idaho, which road commences at a point on Highway 34 in said county on the southern boundary line of Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 40 East; thence runs in a Northeasterly direction through said Section 36, and Sections 31 and 30 of Township 9 South, Range 41 East, Boise Meridian, where said road intersects and terminates at the Bear River.

Section 3: Any person violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject to those fines and penalties as set forth by state statute for infractions.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law, and the erection of traffic control devices along said roadways which set forth the speed limit established herein.
