

ORDINANCE NO. 92-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, STATE OF IDAHO, AMENDING ARTICLE VI OF THE CARIBOU COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 83-1, TO ALLOW BATCH PLANTS AS A CONDITIONAL USE WITHIN AGRICULTURAL ZONES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Public hearing was duly held before the Caribou County Planning and Zoning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners of Caribou County, Idaho, relating to the application by the Planning and Zoning Commission of Caribou County to allow batch plants as a conditional use within Agricultural Zones. No written comments or objections were received at any of said public hearings, and no person present was opposed to said zoning text amendment. It appears to the Board of County Commissioners that it is in the best interest of the County to allow batch plants as a conditional use, on a conditional use permit basis, within Agricultural Zones within county, and the same appears to be in compliance with the Caribou County Comprehensive Plan and the Caribou County Zoning Ordinance.

Section 2: Article VI of the Caribou County Zoning Ordinance, Ordinance No. 83-1, is hereby amended to allow batch plants within Agricultural Zones under a conditional use permit. The Planning and Zoning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners shall have the power to permit or disallow a batch plant as a conditional use within an Agricultural Zone, and they shall further have the power to set such restrictions upon batch plants, if the conditional use permit is granted.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
