

ORDINANCE NO. 95-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, STATE OF IDAHO, DESIGNATING THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE FIRE CHIEF OF CARIBOU COUNTY TO ENFORCE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; REQUIRING PERSONS TO ALLOW INGRESS AND EGRESS FOR THE DIRECTOR AND FIRE CHIEF TO DETERMINE COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ORDINANCE; ESTABLISHING A DISPOSAL SITE AND TIMES AND LIMITS OF DUMPING AND DEPOSITING SOLID WASTE WITHIN THE COUNTY; ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DIRECTOR TO ENFORCE AND INSPECT IN ORDER TO INSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ORDINANCE OR OTHER ORDINANCES RELATED TO SOLID WASTE, HAZARDOUS WASTE AND AIR POLLUTION; ESTABLISHING PROHIBITIONS AS TO OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE COUNTY WITHOUT PERMIT; REQUIRING PERMITS FOR CERTAIN TYPES OF FIRES; ESTABLISHING A TIME PERIOD FOR AN EFFECTIVE PERMIT; ESTABLISHING AN APPEAL PROCEDURE FOR A PERSON DENIED A BURNING PERMIT; PROVIDING THAT CAMPFIRES SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO THIS ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR INCINERATION IN APPROVED INCINERATORS; PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF TOXIC OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In addition to other law enforcement officers of the county, it shall be the duty of the Director of Emergency Services and Public Safety, (hereinafter referred to as Director) or his designated agent, to enforce all provisions of this ordinance. Said person shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this ordinance in all places within unincorporated areas of Caribou County.

Section 2: The Fire Chief of Caribou County, Idaho, shall have the authority to enforce provisions of this ordinance relating to incineration, open burning and other types of burning within the unincorporated areas of the county.
