

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02

AN ORDINANCE OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO PROVIDING FOR ROAD STANDARDS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO; PROVIDING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, MAINTENANCE, REMOVAL, RELOCATING, ALIGNMENT, AND IMPROVEMENT OF ALL ROADS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF CARIBOU COUNTY; ESTABLISHING LIABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR ACTIVITY, DAMAGE AND OR USE INVOLVING SAID ROADS. ESTABLISHING DETECTION AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES AND PENALTIES IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

ARTICLE 1

SECTION A TITLE

This ordinance shall be cited as the official road ordinance of Caribou County, Idaho.

SECTION B PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the activity concerning the Roads within the County and to provide for:

1. The harmonious condition, responsibility, and all issues concerning all roads within the County for all kinds of transportation purposes.
2. The coordination of roads and streets for alignment with other roads and streets.
3. Provide standards for construction, repair, improvement, damage and use of roads.

ARTICLE 2

SECTION A JURISDICTION

These regulations shall apply to all roads within the incorporated area of the County, except those roads included within the Area of City Impact unless negotiation procedures result in a determination to the contrary. See zoning ordinance tables also included with this ordinance: table 8A-County Road, table 8B-Private Road, 8C-Subdivision Road.

SECTION B DEFINITIONS

Road: A right of way which provides access to adjacent properties, the dedication of which has officially accepted and also includes the terms highway thoroughfares, parkway, avenue, boulevard, lane, place and other such terms as:

1. Arterial-A general term including expressways and major arterial streets, and interstate, state or county highways having regional continuity.
2. Frontage-A road running parallel to a state highway or county road providing access to abutting properties.
3. Private-A road that is not accepted for public use or maintenance that provides vehicular and pedestrian access.
4. State Highway- A public road, including its entire right-of-way, under the jurisdiction of the State of Idaho.
5. County Road- A public road, including its entire right-of-way width, under the jurisdiction of Caribou County.

ARTICLE 3

SECTION A RESPONSIBILITY

The person, entity, business, representative, or affiliate that is requesting road change or improvement to any such road for increased traffic or other transportation needs will make those improvements or changes at their expense. Tables 8A, 8B, 8C included with this ordinance will provide the specifications, but no expense including material, equipment or man power for road upgrades due to increased traffic or usage to and from the project site. No activity will be performed on any existing roadway or new roadway without contacting the Road and Bridge Department.

ARTICLE 4

SECTION A ENFORCEMENT

The prosecuting attorney may take whatever steps he\she determines appropriate to civilly enjoin any violation of this ordinance whether or not criminal action is taken. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the Board or any other public official or private citizen taking such lawful action as is necessary to restrain or prevent any violation of this ordinance.




