

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03

AN ORDINANCE OF CARIBOU COUNTY REGARDING WIND ENERGY; SETTING FORTH DEFINITIONS AND STANDARDS; IMPLEMENTING REQUIREMENTS AND A PERMITTING PROCESS; ABANDONMENT TERMS; SETTING FORTH VIOLATIONS, ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES; WAIVING THE RULE REQUIRING THAT THE ORDINANCE BE READ ON THREE SEPARATE OCCASIONS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THE ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE ORDINANCE.

A summary of the principal provisions of Ordinance No. 2017-03 of Caribou County, Idaho, adopted on March 27, 2017.

Section 1. Short title.

Section 2. Setting forth authority.

Section 3. Purpose of the Ordinance is to oversee permitting, protect and preserve public health and safety, and protect the environment.

Section 4. Definitions.

Section 5. Standards.

Section 6. Permitting requirements, fees and expiration are set forth.

Section 7. Permitting procedures are set forth to include the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Section 8. Providing for abandonment of a wind energy system.

Section 9. Setting forth violations for constructing, installing or operating a wind energy system in non-compliance with the ordinance or permit and grandfathering wind energy systems already established unless abandoned.

Section 10. The Building Inspector or designees will have authority relative to administration and enforcement.

Section 11. Penalties and establishing an effective date of the ordinance.




