ORDINANCE NO. 91-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF CARIBOU, STATE OF IDAHO, REPEALING ORDINANCE 95-02; AMENDING ORDINANCE 95-01 TO ADD A SECTION THERETO RELATING TO THE DESIGNATION OF A PUBLIC DISPOSAL SITE FOR THE DUMPING OF SOLID WASTE, THE MAKING OF RULES AND REGULATIONS AFFECTING THE DUMPING AND DEPOSITING OF SOLID WASTE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARIBOU COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 95-02, ordinances of Caribou County, Idaho, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 95-01, is hereby amended to add a new subsection thereto to be designated as Section 5.5 and which shall read as follows:

5.5 The Board shall designate the official public site for the disposal of solid waste. The Board shall also make such rules and regulations as may be needed from time to time as to the manner of time and limits of dumping and depositing solid waste. Such rules and regulations shall be posted on signs designating the area and its use, and by serving the same upon any licensee or contractor having authority to haul or dispose of solid waste. During the hours of operation, a gate attendant will be on duty, and shall have full authority to require the segregation of all materials. Any person or contractor shall follow the directions of said attendant as far as the segregation of said materials. It shall be a violation of this ordinance to refuse to comply with the posted operating rules and regulations or to refuse to comply with the gate attendant's directions. The site will be closed on designate County holidays.

A gate at the entrance to the solid waste facility shall be closed and locked when the disposal site is not in operation. It shall be a violation of this ordinance to tamper with or damage the gate and/or lock of said gate for any reason, or by any means to enter into the solid waste facility when the gate is locked or the facility is closed.

The County Solid Waste Director shall report to the Board of County Commissioners his findings as to the effectiveness of solid waste collections as provided herein and as to violations by any contractor or private person.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
